# Disappearing 9 Patch 

## Little Foot Quilt Shoppe, www.littlefoot.net

Quilt measures approx. 60 " x 60". Easily alter the size by making more or less blocks.

## Materials Needed

- 6 different $1 / 4$ yard cuts of white on black
- 6 different $1 / 4$ yard cuts of black on white
- 1 yard for red center and border
- Binding - $5 / 8$ yard - OR go scrappy - assorted lengths and prints cut into $2 \frac{1}{4}$ " strips.


## Cutting



## Instructions -

Cut (25) $41 / 2 "$ squares red for centers
Cut (100) $41 ⁄ 2{ }^{2 \prime}$ squares black on white
Cut (100) $4112{ }^{12}$ squares white on black
****NOTE - you can use any size squares you want. I used $41 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ because I was using $1 / 4$ yard cuts and that made the most sense.

## 9 Patch Blocks

First, we are going to make 9 patch blocks. I made 25 for this quilt.

My blocks measured $121 / 2$ ".

Next, measure and find the center of your block. Cut block into four sections.


Now we will stitch the four units back into a block! Of course, the possibilities are endless....I did mine like this: My blocks measured about $11 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ at this point. As long as they are all the same size, that's what matters. Don't get too worried about the exact finished size of the blocks.


That's all there is to a Disappearing 9 Patch! I didn't come up with this, and I don't honestly know who did! If this inspires you look up Disappearing 9 Patch on YouTube or Instagram for lots more ideas!!
