

Churn Dash

Little Foot Quilt Shoppe, www.littlefoot.net

Quilt measures approx. 72" x 86". Easily alter the size by making more or less blocks.

Materials Needed

- 12 light fat quarters or fat eighths
- 12 dark fat quarters or fat eighths

Cutting Instructions -

For ONE Block -

Cut (2) 5" squares of dark

Cut (2) 5" squares of light

Cut (1) 4 ½" square light

Cut (4) 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles light

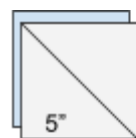
Cut (4) 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles dark



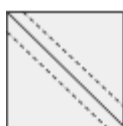
If you want to use sashing like I did in the picture, I used 2 ½" x 12 ½" rectangles of my leftover light fabrics. I also used 2 ½" squares for cornerstones. Also from my leftover fabrics.

Piecing Blocks

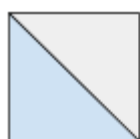
First, we will make Half Square Triangle blocks. Each Churn Dash block requires 4 HST's which measure 4 ½". See diagram →→→, or make using your desired method.



Draw a line diagonally on the back side of the light squares. Layer one med/dark square and one light square, faces together.



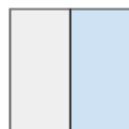
Stitch ¼" on each side of the line. Cut apart on drawn line.



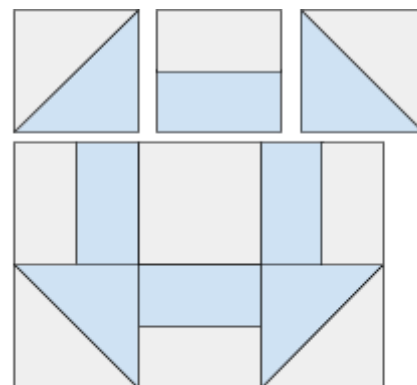
Make 4 HST's.
Trim to 4 ½" if necessary

Size of Quilt

Make this quilt any size you'd like by adding more blocks. I used 30 blocks. A border would also look very nice.



Make 4 per block



Block should measure 12 ½"
