## Churn Dash

## Little Foot Quilt Shoppe, www.littlefoot.net

Quilt measures approx. 72" x 86 ". Easily alter the size by making more or less blocks.

## Materials Needed

- 12 light fat quarters or fat eighths
- 12 dark fat quarters or fat eighths


## Cutting Instructions -

For ONE Block -
Cut (2) 5 " squares of dark
Cut (2) 5" squares of light
Cut (1) $41 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ square light
Cut (4) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles light


Cut (4) $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles dark

If you want to use sashing like I did in the picture, I used $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles of my leftover light fabrics. I also used $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares for cornerstones. Also from my leftover fabrics.

## Piecing Blocks

First, we will make Half Square Triangle blocks. Each Churn Dash block requires 4 HST's which measure $41122^{\prime \prime}$. See diagram $\rightarrow \rightarrow$, or make using your desired method.

## Size of Quilt



Make 4 HST's.
Trim to $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " if necessary
Stitch $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on each side of the line. Cut apart on drawn line.


Block should measure $121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
