$91 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 111 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ blocks


## Cutting Instructions for One Block

From Layer Cake Fabrics AND Background Fabrics Cut:

- $1_{1 / 2 "} \times{ }^{11 / 2 "}$ rectangle-2
- $1 \frac{112 " \prime}{} \times 5 \frac{1}{2} "$ rectangle -2
- $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 7 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle-2
- $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle-2

You will also need a $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2 "$ rectangle for the center of blocks. I cut these from a separate piece of
 fabric.

The diagram shows a 10 " square and how I cut the pieces from the square.

Use $1 / 4 "$ seams to piece blocks together. See illustration above for piecing order. Use $1 / 4{ }^{1 /}$ seam allowance to piece blocks together.
