

# Mini Churn Dash

Little Foot Quilt Shoppe, [www.littlefoot.net](http://www.littlefoot.net)

Quilt measures approx. 22" square

## Materials Needed

- (9) 2 ½" strips dark fabric
- ½ yard background fabric

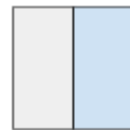
## Cutting Instructions -

### ***From each of the dark 2 ½" strips cut -***

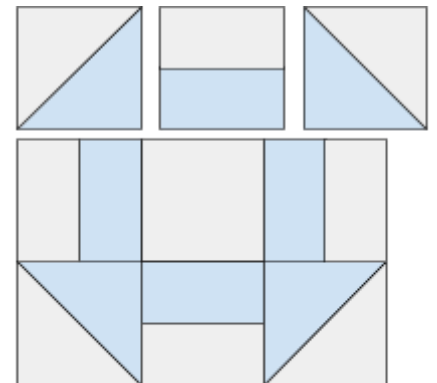
- (5) 2 ½" x 22" pieces for binding
- (2) 2" squares - 16 needed for sashing cornerstones
- (2) 2 ½" squares - 18 total needed
- (4) 1 ¼" x 2" rectangles - 36 total needed

### ***From the background fabric cut -***

- (18) 2 ½" squares
- (36) 1 ¼" x 2" rectangles
- (9) 2" squares
- (24) 2" x 5" rectangles - for sashing



Make 4 per block



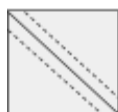
Block should measure 5"

## Piecing Blocks

First, we will make Half Square Triangle blocks. Each Churn Dash block requires 4 HST's which measure 2". See diagram →→→, or make using your desired method.



Draw a line diagonally on the back side of the light squares. Layer one med/dark square and one background square, faces together.



Stitch  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the line. Cut apart on drawn line.

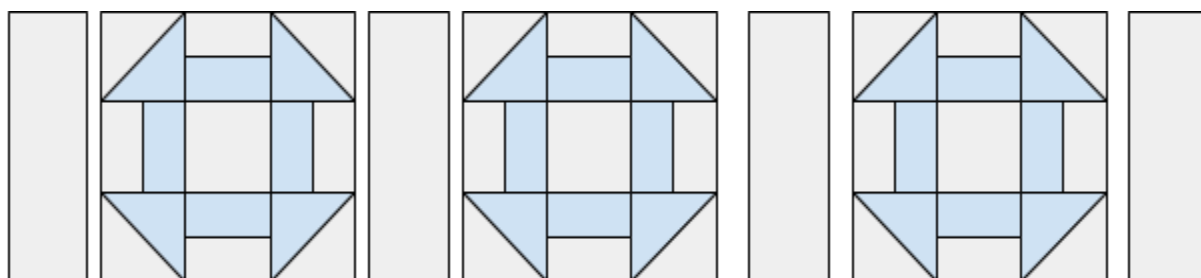


Make 4 HST's.  
Trim to 2" if necessary

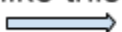
## Layout

Sew blocks and sashing into rows as follows:

rows  
like this
