# Mini Churn Dash

Little Foot Quilt Shoppe, www.littlefoot.net

Quilt measures approx. 22" square

## **Materials Needed**

- (9) 2 1/2" strips dark fabric
- ½ yard background fabric

### **Cutting Instructions -**

### From each of the dark 2 1/2" strips cut -

- (5) 2 1/2" x 22" pieces for binding
- (2) 2" squares 16 needed for sashing cornerstones
- (2) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares 18 total needed
- (4) 1 14" x 2" rectangles 36 total needed


### From the background fabric cut -

- (18) 2 ½" squares
- (36) 1 1/4" x 2" rectangles
- (9) 2" squares
- (24) 2" x 5" rectangles for sashing



Make 4 per block





Block should measure 5"

### **Piecing Blocks**

First, we will make Half Square Triangle blocks. Each Churn Dash block requires 4 HST's which measure 2". See diagram  $\rightarrow \rightarrow \rightarrow$ , or make using your desired method.



Draw a line diagonally on the back side of the light squares. Layer one med/dark square and one background square, faces together.



Stitch ¼" on each side of the line. Cut apart on drawn line.





Make 4 HST's. Trim to 2" if necessary


## Layout

Sew blocks and sashing into rows as follows:

Make 3 rows like this







Make 4 rows like this



2 ½" x 5" Background Fabric 2 ½" square
